## ANZAC Day

Saturday 25 April 2026

As has been a long established tradition, all TCC students are encouraged to represent the College at the ANZAC Day March and/or Dawn Service to remember and give thanks for the many men and women who fought to protect us and our way of life and all those who have given service to our country.

### ANZAC Day March (Rockhampton)

Students participating in the Rockhampton City ANZAC Day March are to assemble in **Alma Street** (see map below) between Archer Street and Cambridge Street (down from Ozcare and Clifford Food Services) by **9:30am**. The March will step off at 9:57am.

The march route is outlined on the map below and will conclude on Quay Street (see below) between Derby Street and Stanley Street. Students can be collected following the march from this location.



### Dawn Service (Rockhampton)

All students are invited to be a part of the TCC contingent attending the Dawn Service. Please meet in the courtyard of **Girls Boarding** (265 Agnes Street) at **3:45am** on **Saturday 25 April** for a 3:50am departure. Students are encouraged to have a light snack before attending. Biscuits and cordial will be served in the Courtyard. Day students may be collected from Girls Boarding from 5:30am depending on the length of the Dawn Service. The traditional Dawn Service will commence at 4:20am and is held at the Rockhampton Botanic Gardens Cenotaph.

## Important Information

All students must wear their formal College uniform, including their hat (not required for Dawn Service). Boys must wear their College tie. Students are to ensure that they are well presented with girls' hair neatly tied back with the correct coloured ribbon only. Students may wear medals that belong to family members or friends and if doing so, protocol states that these must be worn on the right hand side.
